TEMPORARY RELOCATION OF THE “SAN FERNANDO MAGISTRATES’ COURT (OLD COURT)” AND CHANGES IN THE HOURS OF OPERATIONS OF THE “SAN FERNANDO MAGISTRATES’ COURT (OLD COURT)” AND THE “SAN FERNANDO MAGISTRATES’ COURT (MADINAH BUILDING)”

The public is advised that the building known as the San Fernando Magistrates’ Court (Old Court), located at the Corner of Knox and Harris Streets, San Fernando, will continue to be temporarily located at the Supreme Court Building, San Fernando located at Harris Promenade, San Fernando and the building known as the San Fernando Magistrates’ Court (Madinah building), located at No. 7 Court Street, San Fernando until **November 13, 2017**.

The public is reminded that this relocation became necessary in order to conduct urgent repairs to the roof of the building known as the San Fernando Magistrates’ Court (Old Court) building. While the roof works are expected to be completed by November 06, 2017, there are other minor repairs and maintenance that will be undertaken to the interior of the building. The Judiciary seeks the understanding of the public in its efforts to provide a safe environment for all of its customers and staff, and regrets any inconvenience caused.
